The Parish Council has purchased Selecta DNA property marking kits for all households in the parish.

The easy to use kits have been shown to reduce burglary by up to 83% and can be used on smartphones, computers, televisions, bicycles and other high value items in your home to assist police in returning stolen property.

Warning signs in your window and on the street then provide a deterrent to the thieves who risk being marked by the DNA, which can then be detected by police.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

To try and make sure that our unitary authorities are aware of problems with our local roads the Parish Council are hoping to put in place a road adoption scheme.

The idea is that if you adopt a road, you would be responsible for reporting any highway issues online to Cheshire East or Cheshire West and Chester Councils. These can include, flooding, potholes, fly tipping, pavement obstructions, over grown hedges, damaged road signs etc.
